THE AUGUSTINIAN RECOLLECTS CELEBRATE 400 YEARS OF MISSION

ORIGINS AND CHARISM

In 1588, some religious of the Augustinian Order, felt called to live the consecrated life that St. Augustine (354-430) founded in the early Church. They were joined by their brothers in Colombia to live a more recollected way of life and so began the Augustinian Recollects. After more than three centuries of history, in 1912, they were recognized by the Church as an autonomous religious order.

They lived in common following Christ in chastity, poverty and obedience. They followed the Rule of St. Augustine which is summarized in the unconditional love of God, which unites souls and hearts in community of life among brothers. They greatly embrace, contemplative love, community love and apostolic love. The Order is made up of priests, brothers, nuns and sisters; all of them live their vocation by living a fraternal life in community and sharing a mission to fulfil.

EVANGELIZATION IN NINE MISSION TERRITORIES

The Order of Augustinian Recollects is missionary since its birth. Currently, she is responsible for evangelization in 8 mission territories, located in seven different countries: Brazil, Colombia, China, Cuba, Peru, Panama, Taiwan, Sierra Leone and here in England.

EDUCATION

Education is for the Order of the Augustinian Recollects one of the pillars of its apostolate in the world. For more than 400 years, education was always at the forefront of our missions. It was in 1940 when it was decided firmly to open primary and secondary schools.

Currently the Order of Augustinian Recollects works in the educational apostolate with 50 educational institutions (universities, colleges, schools, nursery schools and socio educational centres) around the world.

SOCIAL ACTION – MOVING HEARTS.

The Augustinian recollects do social work

in 20 different countries. The signs of the times demand that the Order is committed to the real problems of society at all times, with a positive option for the poor. They commit themselves to works that promote social justice, solidarity, peace and the care of creation.
