

MESSAGE FROM THE FOUNDER



Welcome to the Anniversary issue of the annual Magazine of HOW TO WRITE FOR SUCCESS LITERARY NETWORK.

In this first issue we are featuring the tributes and articles of writers and Administrators, for the forums' third anniversary that was celebrated on 6th February 2021. The How to Write for Success forum was founded by Trinidadian author BRENDA MOHAMMED on 6th. February 2018.

After her successful entry into the literary world in 2013 and having written a number of books, some of which won awards and became bestsellers, she wrote the book HOW TO WRITE FOR SUCCESS to help new and aspiring authors.

One month after the book's publication, Readers Favorite International gave it a fivestar review. Here is the review:

"Author Brenda Mohammed gives the reader valuable nuggets of truth to use within their own writing career in How to Write For Success.

There is a brief introduction listing the various books the author has written and her ability to encompass different types of literature.

The purpose of this book is to show readers that the author has a passion to help other readers fulfill their lifelong dream of writing their own book. I really appreciated the personal stories on how the author writes her own material and how important research is, even before one begins to write.

She also lists several Facebook groups she has joined to help promote both her material, and herself as an author.

One of the best statements I appreciated within this book is: "A book description is your sales pages. It will sell your book. Make sure it is engaging and can turn a browse into a buy."

This is great and valuable information for a writer to understand.

There is also listed the importance of copyrighting the material, getting an ISBN number, etc. Whoever gets the ISBN number is considered the publisher.

The author has the choice of getting their own or letting the publisher get it for them.

Pre-orders are very important to an author.

Creating excitement before the book is even printed is huge.

There are also many listed things that one can do following publication.

Branding yourself is also very important.

People must know about you and your material, how to find it, and consider reading it.

I really enjoyed all the links provided in the ebook, allowing the reader to go to various publishers, writing aids, Facebook groups, etc.

This is an asset to any writer at any level, given the detailed information, but for the beginner, it is a must-have!"

This review inspired Brenda to start the Literary Forum, 'How to Write for Success'.

On October 9th, 2018, Shiju H Pallithazheth, the Founder of Motivational Strips, the world's most active writers' forum approached Brenda to affiliate her forum with Motivational Strips and she agreed. This affiliation worked in favour of both forums and the benefits were many. Both groups saw an increase in membership.

These were the words of Shiju H. Pallithazheth in his affiliation message:

"Dear Brenda Mohammed,

It gives us immense happiness to know that you have taken the rightful path to develop

writers' acumen by starting 'How to Write for Success' forum. It's not an easy task to write a book and to guide the writers to a path of accuracy and expertise.

The idealism you behold is appreciated as well as the affectionate attitude you possess in abundance. We are sure a person with your attitude have lots of glory to achieve. We all in Motivational Strips are there with you on this mission of writers' empowerment".

Because of the significant growth of the Forum, it is no longer affiliated to Motivational Strips.

In February 2019, How to Write for Success Literary Forum produced an Anthology of Poems to prevent Suicide. 'A Spark of Hope' co-authored by 47 poets of both forums topped the charts of Amazon and became Amazon bestseller No 1 in Poetries and Anthologies.

In August 2019, the book 'How to Write for Success;' topped all the books in the Non-Fiction category of Connections Emagazine Readers' Choice awards and won the gold medal. It also won the silver medal in the overall categories for second place. The first place went to one of Brenda's books, 'Stories People Love.' It was a double victory.

Because of favourable reports received about A Spark of Hope, which saved many from committing suicide, on 11th February 2020, the forum published Volume two of A Spark of Hope. That book, which was coauthored by 64 poets, also topped the charts of Amazon to become bestseller No 1 in Poetries and Anthologies. This also gave rise to a subforum for POEMS FOR SUICIDE PREVENTION.

The increase in Domestic Violence throughout the world raised much concern for poets in both forums. On March 5th,2020, Break the Silence: An Anthology against Domestic Violence, coauthored by 87 poets was published by the forum. That Anthology also topped the charts of Amazon to become bestseller No 1 in Poetries and Anthologies.

Another sub-forum was formed to collect POEMS AGAINST DOMESTIC VIOLENCE.

The merits of the book, 'How to Write for Success' were featured in a comprehensive review in the Ethiopian Herald Sunday Edition on February 16th 2020, by senior journalist Alem Hailu. He gave full details of how it can help new and even seasoned authors.

This is one sentence from his lengthy review, 'As a novelist, book reviewer, and editor myself, I wish I had this book by my bedside for reference in my previous literary pursuits, for unlike other books, I made recourse to, in a bid to fathom the literary devices authors, as well as book reviewers, are expected to well digest, HOW TO WRITE FOR SUCCESS profits a wide array of writers if they, in good time, upload it in their backpacks.'

On 28th May 2020, WORLD NATIONS WRITERS UNION conferred on How to Write for Success Literary Forum a rare and exclusive award to selfless literary institutions that have very high standards of operations, and serve the world of literature selflessly.

On August 15th 2020, it was a moment of pride when the Founder and all Administrators of HOW TO WRITE FOR SUCCESS LITERARY FORUM were honoured by Motivational Strips, the world's most active writers' forum, and Gujarat Sahitya Academy of Gujarat, India for showing Literary Excellence at par with Global standards. To date, the Forum which now has three subforums have a total of 10, 837 members as follows:

To date, she has published thirty- four books.

Her genres include memoirs, science fiction, romance, self-help, mystery, children's books, and poetry.

In fact, her self-help book, 'How to Write for Success,' became an important guide for new and aspiring authors. Besides awards for her books, she received several Global Literature awards during her seven-year writing career.

SPREADING LITERARY TALENT

In its three years of existence, HOW TO WRITE FOR SUCCESS LITERARY FORUM has produced five Anthologies, and each has attained the rank of Amazon No 1 bestseller.

1 SPARK OF HOPE 1: A Treasury of Poems for Saving Lives, was published in February 2019.

49 poets participated in this Anthology to give new hope to those on the verge of suicide. We

have reports that this book, born of an idea by Narendra Rajkumar, edited and published by Founder of HTWFS, Brenda Mohammed, assisted by Chief Administrator Farhana Sait, has saved many lives. The Foreword written by Shiju H Pallithazheth is very encouraging and serves as a deterrent to depressed persons who may be considering suicide.

2. A SPARK OF HOPE 2: A Treasury of Poems for Saving Lives was published in February 2020. The same icons of literature of the HTWFS forum worked on this anthology with 64 poets, who contributed poems to this life-saving project. Because of the need to assure depressed persons that we are there for them, a sub-forum for Poems for Suicide Prevention was established and Chief Administrator Farhana Sait was put in charge.

3.BREAK THE SILENCE: Poems Against Domestic Violence was published in March 2020.

87 poets raised their voices in this Anthology against Domestic Violence. It was spearheaded by the Founder Brenda Mohammed, and edited by Florabelle Lutchman.

The soul-stirring Foreword was written by Shiju H Pallithazheth, Founder of Motivational Strips, the world's most active writers' forum. The response to this project gave rise to the opening of a sub-forum against domestic violence. This forum is growing every day under the expert leadership of Chief Administrator Florabelle Lutchman, who narrates members' poems occasionally.

4.On a lighter note, SWEET MEDLEY: A Poetic Joy, was another book of poems containing birthday tributes for the Founder from 22 poets. It was published with some of her own poems by Founder Brenda Mohammed in December 2020. Vandita Dharni, Chief Administrator wrote the Foreword, and another Chief Administrator, Farhana Sait wrote the Introduction. The book achieved the rank of Amazon bestseller No 1 in the space of two days.

5.JUST FOR YOU: Poetic Flowers was published on February 12th 2020.

33 poets submitted love poems in this Valentine's day Anthology published by the Founder, Brenda Mohammed, who included 40 of her own poems. Shiju H Pallithazheth wrote the brilliant and inspiring foreword, and the book was edited by Florabelle Lutchman. Within one day, it ranked Amazon bestseller No 1 in Love Poems.

What does this tell you? It demonstrates that the Founder Brenda Mohammed is fulfilling her promise of helping new and aspiring authors when she published her self-help book HOW TO WRITE FOR SUCCESS, and established the forum in February 2018.

255 writers who interacted and participated in the Forum's projects can call themselves bestselling co-authors. Isn't that remarkable? In the welcome message for members it states, "We reward high-quality literature."

Our motto on our logo is "Spreading Literary Talent Worldwide."

Until the breath from our lips runs cold and departs.



BOOK REVIEW

How to melt the world into words.

Book: HOW TO WRITE FOR SUCCESS

Aside from relating how the author-poet Brenda Mohammed in an exemplary manner consummated her life journey full of hairpin turns and precipices, and with success navigating the twists and turns of the arduous track of life engaging in different walks of life like insurance and banking, her book entitled HOW TO WRITE FOR SUCCESS renders a handy comprehensive toolkit for writers, critics, and editors.

As a novelist, book reviewer, and editor myself, I wish I had this book by my bedside for reference in my previous literary pursuits, for unlike other books I made recourse to, in a bid to fathom the literary devices authors, as well as book reviewers, are expected to well digest, HOW TO WRITE FOR SUCCESS profits a wide array of writers if they, in good time, upload it in their backpacks.

In demonstrating the devices, presumably at the tip of her fingers, in a vivid and lucid as well as friendly manner, no instructor comes close to Brenda Mohammed, who was in the chalk and talk business earlier in her life, before she branched off into literature.

For instance, tragically as it may sound, most of the books I read recommended "Better show than tell," while they had the propensity of telling. In sharp contrast to this trend, in her book "HOW TO WRITE FOR SUCCESS!" Brenda pragmatically displays the merit of show over tell by inspiring writers to go for it, reviewers to sniff it, editors to weed out flaws, and readers to know what is encumbering them to read fast, and thereby tell a good book from one that compels critics to say the game is not worth the candle.

Substantiating theory with palatable examples that remains seared on the mind, Brenda walks readers of her book through the jungle of literary devices promising a safe return. This way HOW TO WRITE FOR SUCCESS portrays by what means authors unerringly sail to readers' hearts.

As it is true of the other brainchildren of hers like "I'M CANCER FREE," this one too inspires people to go for their burning dreams with a spirit of never say die against the teeth of daunting and innumerable challenges.

Using short, simple, and toothsome sentences she is a past master at making true modern style never fail to arouse readers' appreciation. They are showcases of the power of the pen for authors who have to emerge tall scouting the footprints of literary giants like herself. It exemplifies poetic prose that glues to the pages of the eyes of those who happen to pick the book. Literariness is how to make things picturesque without using pictures. Brenda is gifted in doing that simply leaning on word pictures. She knows how to use the best word at the best place as she is a poet too, and as she states, "to make readers gravitate to you!" Make your expressions flowery she says in flowery words. In short, she melts the world into words inviting writers to follow suit.

It is not only in how to use the writers' craft the page-turner book stands tall, it also hones emerging authors' skill demonstrating how to trim unnecessary words and expressions. For instance, it practically shows how to avoid weak verbs or verbs modified by adverbs. She demonstrates to writers, "He sprinted," is by far better than "He ran quickly". She also shows the advantage of avoiding hidden verbs "We will announce the winner next week" to "We will make an announcement of the winner next week." This is a good tip for those engaged in editorship as well.

Such useful tips she raises, apply to nonfictional works too if the balance mix is well checked.

Observably, her background with an educator like her father has lent her the necessary skills to drive her point home effortlessly. Author-poet Brenda recommends the writer has to lean on his/her intuition to effectively portray body language. This lulu that shot up to the global helm of success advises writers to put themselves in the shoes of the character under description. By way of exemplifying this, she says the way the writer's body gives away his/her emotion to flattery could be easily adapted to the characters, whose behaviors and physical features have to be well expressed. She capitalizes on the need to focus on characters' internal dialogues, (monologues) as well as the external ones.

To engage the readers in using their feelings, HOW TO WRITE FOR SUCCESS shows the importance of using action than dialogue tags that slows the story's pace. << Instead of "Yes," he said>> it is better to use<< "Yes" he nodded.>>

Writers have to come up with a clean sheet as much as possible as spelling and grammatical errors could belittle them in readers' eyes and strips them of credibility. In a world full of skeptics, one typographical error, especially on cover pages, could make readers put an axe on the neck of the author. It is no secret book stations back off if a reader draws their attention to such mistakes. I know firsthand that most publishers even those that claim they publish for free ask for payment to correct such silly mistakes even if they know most authors are financially constrained and live in a country where the transaction of hard currency is virtually impossible.

Books that sell like hot cakes standing out from the crowd are ones that have a good blurb, advertisements and book reviews. She advises authors to take time to produce works that wow their target readers and attract attention to the sale of their books.

"Use active voice to passive voice," is also among the writing tips she demonstrates with better examples.

Regarding novels and short stories, the story premise must be clear for readers to keep track, she stresses. To ram this home "Believable characters are the lifeblood of the story," she points out.

Life in the story must not reflect a bed of roses, nor must characters be flawless and physically striking, she recommends to authors expected to evade the relegation of their work to the category prosaic. The protagonist and main character should face physical or other shortcomings they have to overcome

Though show to tell is recommendable narration and dialogues must be in the right mix, advises Brenda.

When painting, the setting be it historic setting— with political and cultural wrangling— or otherwise, writers have to conduct research to avoid mistakes like an anachronism. As the story has to be believable double-checking things is a mustdo. She substantiates this with the study she conducted to craft a science fiction. "Take readers on a literary pilgrimage!" and "Create a believable world!" "Use all of your five senses," Brenda recommends.

Though it is recommendable to design plots at times, characters could allow the writer a room to go a bit astray in so far as this action does not contradict the main plot. "A story arch is not set in stone!" she says. She underlines the need to focus on subplots as well. She appreciates plot summaries before attempting writing to evade getting sucked in a black hole.

When it comes to the narrative she advises limiting description and avoiding ramblings

resorting to intriguing and dramatic situations. The problem and the story must be wellgrounded. The premise has to be clear.

Before publications, it sure is good for readers to get their book perused by friends or relatives who are avid readers. Beta readers and editing software could render invaluable services in weeding out errors and checking self-contradictory issues. It sure is good if a seasoned editor sees the final output before publication because a professional has experienced eyes in rendering the masterpiece a finishing touch.

She also shows how novelists could keep on writing to the end in a three months' time setting, with a program of writing, say 500 words per day. She also highlights the advantage of quietude such as night time, while writing as a distraction is formidable of creative art.

Her book also throws light on the significance of growing in a close-knitted, well-educated and reading family.

Above all, she capitalizes writers must well know their target audience to tailor works accordingly. They as well should have a worldview to make their work a hit. As I found the writer imperfectly perfect I could not find any flaws in the book. Check this must-read yourself.


