It is a true testament to our Technical Director, coaches and program that we have so much depth in our junior ranks which will eventually flow through to our Seniors and continue to grow a strong club into the future.

Despite Covid-19 restrictions our Saturday's were well attended, particularly Saturday night home games and for those that came down, everyone was always treated to a great atmosphere, some good food and exciting football. Covid-19 wasn't all bad news for us. There were some silver linings for us - firstly, the delayed start allowed our fields to get a bit more rest and secondly we were successful in obtaining some additional grant funding. This included finally getting a decent PA system. We can now pump all that great 80's music right across the grounds and get on the microphone to announce that "number 7 your hamburger, chips & gravy and curry is ready". A big thanks to the State Government for this funding and to Noosa Council for other Grant funding received throughout 2020.
