



A Demonstration by

Wolfgang Shulz-Zachau

On Thursday 5th March 2020 at Shilton Village Hall.

This demonstration by Wolfgang Shulz-Zachau has proved to be the last demonstration before the coronavirus hit to close down our activities for the for-seeable future and it was good to see a good number of members attending.

Wolfgang started by giving us a potted history of his life and how he became involved in the craft of woodturning.





Wolfgang started his demonstration Wolfgang Shulz-Zachau by allowing the

audience to select the wood (Yew) for making a bud vase. There followed an in depth teaching mainly aimed at absolute beginners within the club but I am sure that others present managed to glean some knowledge throughout the demo. Tools were explained and their cor-

rect use with emphasis the on roughing gouge

and Wolfgang quite rightly said that its true name was "Spindle Roughing Gouge" and should not be used on cross grain work at all. A spindle gouge was used to do the final shaping but Wolfgang also demonstrated using the skew chisel which as we know can be difficult even for the more experienced woodturner. This was rather a large bud vase being turned on a small lathe so when it came to drilling the hole in the piece Wolfgang was

not able to use the tailstock with Jacobs chuck fitted so this was removed and a spindle gouge was used to begin the drilling process. After a

certain depth of hole had been reached it was now possible to refit the tail-




stock and chuck with a drill mounted in it so that a hole could be formed to an exact diameter to




enable a plastic, or was it a glass test tube to be inserted therefore allowing water to be held in it for the flower bud.

Sanding brought the piece to a smooth finish so that the final wax finish could be applied and Wolfgang completed a very nice object.

For his second project of the evening Wolfgang decided




We were shown a jig which Wolfgang uses to hold the wood whilst he turns the off centre piece and then he proceeded to use this on the lathe.





at the more experienced turner but I am sure that everyone present was entertained and learned a lot watching the piece come to fruition. The final part of this project was turning the pin and Wolfgang achieved this in double quick time.




EMERGING BOWL

This produces an intriguing emerging bowl which may utilise a natural edge or subsequent decoration. Start with wood with proportions 3 x 3 square and 4 long. The wood may be all excellent quality for two emerging bowls, or half may be waste wood. The block may be whole and cut in half later; or cut in half and re-assembled with a paper joint, glue, or strong binding before you start turning.







Mark it up with your intended centre marks and cuts.



Mount the wood between centres and cut a chuck bite on one face.



Remount in a chuck and cut the emerging part to an exact hemisphere. Sand this surface.



Remove the wood from the chuck and saw off the chuck bite. Then separate the block into two halves. One half may be wasted or used to make a second Emerging Bowl. On the piece you plan to finish, carefully measure and mark on the flat surface of the bowl the exact centre of the diameter. Attach the wood to a faceplate. Hotmelt glue is recommended. To ensure that the centre of the bowl is at the centre of the faceplate bring the tailstock up to the central mark you made.

Add glued-in support blocks around the bowl.

Hollow the bowl. Sand and finish the inside.



Remove the wood from the faceplate.

Dress and finish all the flat surfaces.




