



# TREE MARKING PAINT

An Acrylic emulsion paint based paint. Formulated to provide good performance at an economical price.

## SURFACE PREPARATION

Always ensure the substrate is clean, dry and free of contaminants e.g. oil, grease, wax, dirt, etc. prior to application of tree marking paint.

## APPLICATION

Stir contents thoroughly, use as supplied. Do not dilute. 2 Coats of 50µ each are recommended for optimum results.

Airless spray: Not suitable  
Conventional spray: Not suitable  
Brush and Roller: Suitable as supplied. Do not dilute.  
Clean up: Wash with Water

## ENVIRONMENT

It is recommended that application be confined to the following:

Surface temperature: Min. 15°C Max. 40°C  
Ambient temperature: Min. 15°C Max. 40°C  
Relative humidity: Min.0% Max.85%  
Or at least 3°C above Dew point

## DRYING TIME

Substrate Temp	Touch Dry	Hard Dry
15°C	4 hours	8 hours
20°C	2 hours	4 hours
25°C	1 hour	2 hours
30°C	30 minutes	1 hour

## OVERCOATING TIMES

15°C: 8 hours  
20°C: 4 hours  
25°C: 2 hours  
30°C: 1 hour

## LIMITATIONS

Sustained cold conditions can result in paint failure.  
Avoid painting on wet substrates and in wet conditions

## STORAGE AND HANDLING

Store in a cool dry area, away from heat, direct sunlight and severe cold.  
Shelf life: 18 months in original sealed containers.

## LIMITATIONS

Sustained cold conditions can result in paint failure.  
Avoid painting on wet substrates and in wet conditions.

## SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

No known problems resulting from contact with skin, however, remove as soon as possible with soap and water. Avoid ingestion and contact with eyes. If ingested, seek medical attention. Do not induce vomiting. If paint contact is made with eyes, rinse eyes well with water and seek medical attention.

Do not smoke when painting.  
Ensure good ventilation during painting and drying.
