- 1) The meeting was called to order at 10:02 A.M.
- 2) Meeting Safety Briefing was given by Vice Chairman, Rick Nolle.
- 3) Consent Agenda (Single Motion Needed):
 - a. Approval of Agenda and Order of Business, from the 3/28/2019 Board Meeting were motioned by Walker and seconded by William. Passed unanimously.
- **4) Meeting Minute:** Approval of Meeting Minutes from 2/28/19, motioned by Walker and seconded by Williams.
- 5) Public Comment:

Reinette Senum, Nevada City Vice Mayor, shared there would be a software recap of the "Flamemapper" program that the city is considering using. It will be held 3/28/18 at 1:30PM.

6) Agency/Partner Reports:

Jecobie Water of USFS reports on status of a 4300-acre project. They have already completed 100 acres of understory burning and expect to complete another 80 soon. A 40 HR Basic Firefighter Training is coming up April 15th.

Matt Furtado, Nevada County Fire Prevention Planner and Deputy Fire Marshall reported for Cal Fire on the upcoming WUI Drill on April 7th in LOP. Cal Fire will commence Phase 2 staffing on April 15th.

Supervisor Sue Hoek reported on the new vegetation ordinance adopted by County of Nevada. The county also approved a new partnership between OES and Nevada County Consolidated FD to run the Nevada County OES Inspection Program. Jeff Pettit is the new Director of OES.

Jenn Tamo of OES reported on the Firewise Speakers' series. There are two remaining events, April 15th and June 10th. The Wildfire Preparedness a Children's Safety Carnival will be held on May 4th and interested parties can RSVP on the Ready Nevada County site.

Susan Rogers reports the Speakers Bureau is active and scheduling. The Firewise Coalition continues to take FW Community inquiries. Coalition meetings will be moving to Esterly Hall.

The Fire Chiefs Association is overwhelmed with outreach and education obligations.

Cathe' Fish of Master Gardner's reports she is happy with the continuous flow of information. Some confusion has delayed an updated plant list form Master Gardner's. There are useful lists and links on the Placer County Master Gardner's site. The Northern Nevada list is also a beneficial tool.

7) Report of the Executive Committee:

- a. E/F Committee Approval of Staff Expansion and Pay Schedules. Weston motioned to approve Wagner seconded. Passed unanimously.
- b. Director Approval Process Policy. Walker motioned, Doerr seconded.
- c. Board Committee Assignments/Executive/Finance Committee composition discussion. The committees are open to any Director to serve on so long as the committee is mindful of size and odd numbers.
- d. Committee name changes were approved. The Personnel Committee will be change to the Human Resources Committee and a Director Nomination Committee was formed. Motioned by Eubanks, Doerr seconded.
- e. Next Executive/Finance committee meeting will be held on April 11th, 2019.

8) Report of the Chairman of the Board – Rick Nolle for Donn Thane:

- a. Helene Hall submitted her resignation as a Director of the Fire Safe Council of Nevada County Board. Public recognition of Helene's contribution should be discussed at a future time.
- b. A motion was made by Walker to reconvene the Director Nomination Committee and to recruit the open position of Secretary, Doerr seconded.
- c. Hanke Weston's Distinguished Citizen Dinner is coming up and all proceeds will go to the Breaking Down Walls Foundation at Rough and Ready School.
- d. The DSAV class is full at 80 attendees.

9) Report from the Finance Committee:

a. Treasurer Walker provided an outline of FSCNC's current financials. The mislabeled items on the Balance Sheet and P&L still are causing confusion. ED Jones discussed the changes to address the concerns in the upcoming Fiscal Year. For audit purposes, the items will not change until the new fiscal year. A new bookkeeper to replace LVG Accounting is being hired and will start in the coming months to get the financials back on track and closed on a monthly basis again.

10) Report from the Executive Director:

- a. California Conservation Core should be with us in Fall, they will likely say at Oak Tree Park
- b. FSC has met with the RCD to discuss future partnerships, including Fire Season Guide, Air Curtain Burner and potential funding opportunities.
- c. ED Jones thanked the board for their participation in the Ethics Class. Green waste drop sites will be active through the month of May. Changes and updates to policies and employee manuals will be forthcoming. FSC has streamlined operations through some additional software for time tracking. They are looking to change providers for phone lines due to inconsistency with the current provider and outdated equipment. The website separately needs to be redesigned.
- d. Marty Main has been extremely helpful in taking over this years Fire Season Guide.
- e. The Cal Fire Safe Council Clearinghouse Grant is active. The Cal Fire Grants will be awarded in April. FEMA is still looming with no timelines at this point.
- f. The County Roads Project is nearly complete. The County of Nevada has amended our contract to include \$10,000 to certify 10 Firewise Communities by June 30th, 2019.
- g. The staff has been increased to include a full time Chipping Supervisor and a Project Manager for the Ponderosa West Project. Billy Spearing is now a full time Grant Accountant. Anna Cox is out on a non-work-related injury. Janet McFadden has been assisting in the office in a temporary position. We have 2 OJT Supervisors being reimbursed at 75% and 2 Workforce Crews.

13) Director Comments:

Rick Noelle commented that the Chipping Program should really be promoted. It has always had county support thanks to Hank Weston. He was instrumental in securing funding to help the program continue all these years.

Eric Trygg stated that he would like to ensure the Volunteer Luncheon happens and is willing to coordinate it.

Pete Williams asked the board to consider the committees they would like to participate in come back next month with their responses.

Wanda Mertens stated that FSCNC is being watched closely at the state level as a successful example of coordination and effort. She informed the board the California State Fair Plan will be giving a discount to members of Firewise Communities.

Donn Wagner reiterated Hank Weston's role in securing Title III and Prop 172 funding from the county.

Billy Spearing discussed the history of our organization as requested by Chairman Thane. The chipping program has been running for 22 years. FSC started as a community action group after the 49er Fire and continued to form the first Fire Safe Council. The founders went on to create the California Fire Safe Council. Billy then went on to encourage the organization to educate the community on Emergency Planning with their families.

14) Closed Session (Only Voting Board Members May Participate):

The Vice Chair, Rick Nolle reported out of closed session that the Directors agreed and approved the Executive Director is to be paid the full salary as outlined in the ED Employment Contract. In addition, any deferred salary accrued should be paid out at this time as well.






