

Are you ready to start a new class? To meet new student? To say hello to returning students? It's that time of the year again. How exciting it is to bring something to others that brings us so much joy!

I'm asking each and every one of you to participate actively in recruiting for our new class. Even if you are not among the angels who support the class weekly you can help by advertising the lessons on Nextdoor.com. If you are not already signed up, please type "nextdoor" in your google bar and click "join". Or, you could ask my Plus class partner, Dana, to invite you to be a member, which is easier. Dana's email is darksy@roadrunner.com. In case you didn't know, he is the one who first suggested posting an advertisement for our classes on Nextdoor.com a few years ago. Nextdoor, Meet-up, and of course personal invitations are the ways we have brought in most of our new dancers. I have used the same basic post in Nextdoor since the beginning, just changing the dates and anything else that seemed appropriate. This time, I made a few more changes, based on what I learned from the marketing experts at the National Square Dance Convention. There is a "hidden gem" that is close by. I'd love to introduce you to a great class that brings me boundless joy.

Square Dancing is a wonderful opportunity to move aerobically to music and singing, while interacting with new people, having a lot of fun, enjoying refreshments and making new friends. We have a live caller/instructor. The first class is free whether you start on September 11th or September 18th and the rest are only \$7 each.

Come as a single person or as a couple. We have experienced partners for you if you want. Dress casually and wear comfortable shoes. Many of us who dance regularly come to the classes every week to partner with the new students. We dance in our neighborhood, at Felicia Mahood Multipurpose Auditorium: 11338 Santa Monica Blvd, LA 90025 (enter off of Corinth) 1 block west of Sawtelle. There is free parking in the back and at the end of the block at the NW corner of Corinth & Iowa, after 4 p.m.

You will be delightfully surprised by how much fun it is. The beginner's class is from 7:00 pm -8:30 p.m. every Wednesday; then we have a break with snacks and conversation. At 8:45 a more complex (called Plus) class starts. I, personally, square dance 3 times a week now, because I get such joy from it. Give it a try, you have nothing to lose and a lot to gain.

Other clubs are offering their class once a year and would be encouraged to offer it more often. The A Square D General Meeting voted to proceed with the process of looking into marketing. Delegates will take the marketing ideas to their clubs for feedback and bring the results to the November A Square D General Meeting. Lastly, we discussed clubs

For marketing, we want to saturate the market with messages about square dancing. Topics discussed were first the answer to "What are we marketing?" Answer: fun, socializing, friendship, dancing, and community. What we are not marketing are health and petticoats, as these are not selling points. 
We'll be staying at a hotel connected to the convention center. That's already arranged.
