



Radford Semele Neighbourhood Plan Referendum



Vote “Yes” on 6th May

The final stage of development of the Neighbourhood Plan for Radford Semele is a referendum to be put to villagers. This will take place on 6th May alongside the Warwickshire County Council and the Police and Crime Commissioner elections.

There will be a single choice, Yes or No to the question -

“Do you want Warwick District Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Radford Semele to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?”

We are hopeful there will be a resounding “Yes” to the plan which has been 4½ years in the making, consulting with the village, local businesses, and voluntary groups.

The Plan has 13 policies to help manage and sustain the village of Radford Semele and if accepted must be considered alongside the Warwick District Council Local plan on any decisions made with regards to planning and development in Radford Semele.

What does it do? –

It will guide the future development of our parish: -

- Helps Protect sensitive areas from unwanted development,
- Helps Protect Village character, Identity & History,
- Puts in a level of protection for community assets, the environment, sensitive green spaces and views,
- Informs Warwick District Council and Warwickshire County Council about what is important to the community such as footpaths, cycling, landscape, traffic management and local economy.
