Bendigo is Victoria's fourth largest city with a rich and prosperous heritage dating back to the days when gold was discovered in the area in the 1850s. Since then, Bendigo has been the second highest producing goldfield in Australia and remains the seventh largest in the world. Bendigo's rich gold history has produced a city of unparalleled opulence and grandeur.

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Day 1 – Monday– Home to Bendigo

This morning we welcome everyone on-board as we begin our journey towards the historical town of **Bendigo**. Stopping along the way for **morning tea** we head towards **Castlemaine**, a former gold mining town. Whilst here we head to the **Castlemaine Mill**. This historic site started as the Castlemaine Woollen Mill in 1875 before being transformed into the place for foodies, art admirers and seekers of the collectable and curious. There will be some time to **explore some of the interesting and eclectic businesses** operating here. Please do visit the amazing food hall and purchase yourself some lunch. Those who prefer, are welcome to visit the **Castlemaine Botanical gardens** (one of the earliest of Victoria's many botanic gardens) located just across the road and enjoy a stroll around the native and exotic trees. After we have shopped & strolled, we board the bus and head directly to Bendigo and our lovely motel – home for the next 4 nights. You will have plenty of time to unpack and relax before we head to the **Lakeside restaurant** for a delightful **2 course dinner**.

Day 2 – Tuesday – Eaglehawk

This morning we enjoy a stunning **cooked breakfast** before we spend the day exploring some of the local area. We will start with a **tour of the town** followed by a visit to **Sandhurst Goal**. Bendigo's Ulumbarra Theatre rises majestically from within what was once the Sandhurst Gaol. Our knowledgeable guide shares the stories of inhabitants old and new, while exploring this world class performance facility. After a remarkably interesting morning we head to the **Kangaroo Flat Sports Club** to enjoy a lovely lunch. After lunch we make our way to **Eaglehawk** and **The Great Stupe of Universal Compassion**. A stupa (also known as a pagoda) is the most sacred building in Buddhism. We will enjoy a **guided tour** here and learn a little more about the project. We will visit the grounds of the **Peace Park** and view the **Jade Buddha** for Universal Peace. Following our enlightening afternoon, we spend some time in **the lovely town of Eaglehawk** with visits to the **Lock Up, Courthouse and Town Hall**. Heading back towards Bendigo we will stop at **Lake Tom Thumb** for a small stroll and to see if we can spot any birdlife. Once back in Bendigo we will enjoy another 2-course dinner at the Lakeside restaurant.



Day 3 – Wednesday – Maldon & Victorian Goldfields Railway

This morning we Journey to **historic Maldon** and experience what life was like during the gold rush era. Wandering past old weatherboard homes, solid stone buildings and decorative shop fronts in this lovingly preserved **Australian gold mining town**. Grab yourself some lunch and a coffee at one of the lovely little sidewalk cafes and **browse the many antique and collectable shops** around town. After lunch we make our way to **Victorian Goldfields Railway** to step back in time and board our **first-class carriage** for our memorable **steam rail trip** through the goldfields of central Victoria back to Castlemaine. Purchase a drink or snack from one of the stewards while you sit back and relax and let the world drift by. What a way to travel!! Arriving in Castlemaine, Kevin will meet you at the platform and escort you to the bus for a short trip back to Bendigo. With plenty of time to relax we look forward to seeing you at dinner!

Day 4 – Thursday – Bendigo

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After a hearty cooked breakfast, we head out to explore Bendigo a little more. There is no better way to see the sights of Bendigo than aboard one of the iconic **Vintage Talking Trams**. A Vintage Talking Tram Tour is the quickest way to get your bearings and see the city's key landmarks and monuments. We will visit the **Central Deborah Gold Mine, Alexandra Fountain, Bendigo Woolen Mills, The tramways depot & workshop, Lake Weeroona, Tysons Reef and PepperGreen Farm.** The folk here are passionate about growing fresh produce and showcasing the culture and heritage unique to Central Victoria. Whilst here we will enjoy lunch in the farm kitchen that incorporates fresh produce from the garden wherever possible. We'll return back to Central Deborah gold mine to collect the bus before our final stop for the day at the **Golden Dragon Museum**. A full day of exploring this historic city done mostly in the comfort and convenience of the Vintage Talking Tram. Another lovely dinner tonight at the Lakeside restaurant.
