Flange Head With TX Drive

This increases the bearing area, provides a tighter connection and increased resistance to head pull through. The TX head provides optimum torque transfer.



Under-Head Milling Ribs

The milling ribs on the CSK screw countersink the screw head, creating a more precise and neater finish.



Shank Ribs

Shank ribs reduce driving torque by reaming the hole, speeding up insertion and increasing battery life.



Serrated Thread

Special cutting notches on the thread cut wood structural fibres while the screw is advancing.



Special Cutting Point

Notched thread tip makes the start of the installation easier and prevents timber from splitting.
