#### **Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)**

**Qn: What is the difference between all your workshops?**

**Ans:** There are 3 Workshops in total.

1. Around the World in 80 days (ATW) Book analysis - Catered to adults.
2. Family Friendly book analysis - Toned down content for 9yr olds and above.
3. Immersive Children's book workshop - for ages 3 - 9, no food samples.

**Qn: What is the difference between the current workshops and the usual Andsoforth experiences.**

**Ans:** There will be more hands-on activities compared to our usual experience, just like a workshop, the experience will be educational, entertaining and instructional. Following the current regulations and guidelines from the government to ensure safety, there will be no live performances.

**Qn: What is the difference between the regular workshop and the family friendly workshop?**

**Ans:** The book analysis workshop is mainly for adults as our facilitators talk about the controversial material in the book eg. racism, sexism, money, power etc. For the family friendly workshop, we tone it down a little to suit ages 9 and above. Also the food samples for the young one are tweaked to suit their palettes and portions are adjusted to prevent food wastage.

**Qn: Is this suitable for my 2/3 year old? will they require a ticket?**

**Ans:** As this experience spans a total of 150mins, your little one's attention span, patience and ability to be polite might run out. This would affect the other attendees and the experience. Hence, we strongly suggest attending the CHILDREN'S BOOK WORKSHOP at [www.andsoforthjr.com.sg](http://www.andsoforthjr.com.sg)  
Each wave can only fit a maximum number of 10pax all socially distanced, we cannot grantee the safety of your little one should they sit in between other strangers, also it would be against the law.

**Qn: What is the difference between the family friendly workshop and the children's book workshop shop?**

**Ans:** The family friendly workshop is 150mins, spans 7 rooms and has food samples. The Children's book workshop is 75mins, spans 5 rooms and has No food samples.

**Qn: Do I have to write a book? Do I have to read and study the book?**

**Ans:** The book analysis workshop will extract key moments/highlights from the book; Around the World in 80 Days and bring them to life with the use of facilitators in character and the most amazing sets. Do not worry as you will not need to take notes or bring the book. This is our most ambitious work to date and even though we cannot do live singing (because no vocal projections law by the gov) we've adapted the format to stay within the guidelines to still be magnificent!

**Qn: Will there still be food and drinks?**

**Ans:** No, in this children's book workshop, there are no food samples provided. Should you like food samples please proceed to [andsoforth.com.sg](http://andsoforth.com.sg) for the family friendly workshop happening on the 29th Nov and 6th Dec.

**Qn: I bought tickets but I'm not into workshops, can I get a refund?**

**Ans:** Do note that as per the terms and conditions that tickets sold are non-refundable and nonexchangeable. Your ticket credit is still valid for 1 year from the date of purchase should you want to redeem it for a later production.

**Qn: Given the Covid-19 situation, I am no longer comfortable attending the experience, can I get a refund?**

**Ans:** Please know that we totally understand your rational and will be taking strict precautions at this workshop. However, as per the terms and condition, tickets sold are non-refundable and nonexchangeable. We are able to accommodate should you like to pass your ticket to a friend or someone else.

**Qn: What are the safety measures that will be in place?**

**Ans:** Every guest will be temperature screened at the door, 37.5deg and above will be turned away from the workshop, safe entry code will need to be scanned and check in and out of the premise is compulsory. There are no Identity card scanners, you are required to have a phone to scan the QR code.

Every room is designed for 25 pax, but is reduced to fit 10 pax to adhere to Social distancing guidelines. All staff will be wearing masks and facilitators, face shields as per workshop guidelines.

Hand sanitisers will be placed at every exit of each door and every attendee will be required to sanitise their hands before and after each workshop area. Anyone who does not follow the safety guidelines will immediately have their photo taken via cctv and staff phone for evidence later, and be escorted to leave the premise without a ticket refund.

If there is a failure to comply, the police will be notified. (Yes, the police know of the workshop and are on standby) Please, for your own safety and the safety of others, listen and follow instructions from our staff and we will all have an amazing time.
