Our tour will begin in the mess-hall. This is a the commons area of the ship where everyone is welcome to come in and share casual chats, jokes, and memes.


The holodecks are our next destinations. This is the place to show up for fun. Trivia and organized entertainment will be held in these two rooms.

Last but certainly not least, we end our tour with the magnificent view of the bridge. Here is where you'll find important ship-wide announcements and news.




