- B All entries must be grown by the exhibitor
- C All fruits and vegetables will be judged according to the STANDARDS OF PERFECTION as issued by the Ministry of Agriculture 250-398-4500

- 1 Beans, climbing, 6 pods
- 2 Beans, yellow, 6 pods
- 3 Beans, green, bush, 6 pods
- 4 Beans, other, 6 pods
- 5 Beets, 5 roots
- 6 Broccoli, 1 head or lateral shoots
- 7 Brussels sprouts, 6 specimens
- 8 Cabbage, green, 1 head
- 9 Cabbage, red, 1 head
- 10 Carrots, long, over 7", 5 roots
- 11 Carrots, intermediate, 4"-7", 5 roots
- 12 Carrots, short, under 4", 5 roots
- 13 Cauliflower, 1 head
- 14 Celery, 2 specimens
- 15 Corn, sweet, 5 ears, 1/3 husk removed
- 16 Cucumbers, long English, 2 specimens
- 17 Cucumbers, slicing, 2 specimens
- 18 Cucumbers, pickling, 6 specimens
- 19 Kale, one plant
- 20 Kohlrabi, 2 specimens
- 21 Lettuce, leaf, one bunch
- 22 Onions green, bunching, 6 onions

FIELD CROPS:

- 59 Hay, grass, including native meadow, one bale approx. 50 lbs.
- 60 Hay, mixed/legume grass, one bale, approx. 50 lbs.
- 61 Sunflower head, largest diameter
- 62 Tallest sunflower, root ball included in container
- 63 Core sample of a round bale, put core in a 1L Zip Lock bag

ORCHARD:

- 64 Apple, 3 specimens, state kind on entry tag
- 65 Crab Apples, 6 specimens, state kind on entry tag
- 66 Any fruit not listed above, 3-6 specimens, state type of fruit on entry tag
- 67 Dehydrated fruit, 3 specimens, state kind on entry tag

FARM PRODUCE:

- 68 Eggs, white, 6
- 69 Eggs, brown, 6
- 70 Eggs, other, 6
- 71 Egg, smallest, domestic, one specimen
- 72 Egg, largest, domestic, one specimen
- 73 Honey, clear, a one pint jar
- 74 Honey, granulated, a one pint jar
- 75 Frame of honey, deep or shallow, one
- 76 Beeswax, 3 cakes, min 1/4 lb. each
- 77 Fleece of unwashed wool
- 78 **"Pirates of the Carrots & Beans"** a scarecrow illustrating the 2019 Harvest Fair Theme, not to exceed 6' in height

- 80 Salt Block Art, naturally formed, display on base, no larger than 14"x14", must
