Your Pairing Administrators are getting ready for the first play day on April 1st. We are asking for your help this year to make things run smoothly. The signup deadline is 5:00 p.m. the Thursday before the play day and we are limited to 84 players due to cart availability. Please sign-up on Total-e before the deadline. This is especially helpful on weeks where it is a team game. If you miss the sign-up you must call the Pairings Administrator listed on the WGA website Play Day Information/Tee Times tab by Monday at 5:00 p.m. If you add after Monday 5:00 p.m. no guarantees are made that you will get a tee time as that is determined based on the limit of 84 players, play day format, player handicap, and is up to the discretion of the Pairings Administrator. Scorecards are printed on Tuesday so it is more difficult to make changes after Monday night.

Handicaps for WGA play are calculated based on your USGA Handicap index on the day the tee times are made. This is usually the Friday before we play.
