BELOW ARE GENERAL GUIDELINES THAT THE ALL COUNTY SOCCER CLUB ASKS ALL PARENTS TO FOLLOW.

- 1. We will not criticize the Referee openly or directly, during or after the game. Any issues need to be addressed to the Coach and they will bring it to the attention of the League Officials.
- 2. We will cheer and encourage our team, in a positive manner.
- 3. We will do our best to encourage our players to be students of the game.
- 4. We will encourage sportsmanship by teaching our players to thank the Referees & Coaches after the game no matter the outcome.
- 5. We will do our best to have our child prepared for every game and practice which includes, but is not limited to, wearing the appropriate gear, providing the appropriate hydration, and being on time.
- 6. We will be supportive of the Players, Coaches, and Referees during games.
- 7. While cheering and supporting our team, we will leave the coaching to the Coach.
- We understand that inappropriate behavior at the game may result in a parent being asked to leave the field by the Referee, or League Official.
- 9. We understand that the League, if necessary, can prohibit a parent from watching their child play should a problem arise that would threaten the safety and well-being of anyone associated with ACSC: Player, Coach, Referee, or another Parent/Spectator.
- 10. We agree to have as much fun watching the game as our children/players should have playing the game.
