

Hello my awesome CCCA families!

Here is the email that you all are waiting for... maybe not... but I hope to answer all of your questions as we deal with something that we have never dealt with before. First of all.... school is not over! Even though students are not entering our building every day... teachers will still be lesson planning, grading, and assessing progress, so you are not going to become homeschool teachers... you will continue to monitor their work.. just like you always do.

Teachers will be using schoolworx to upload any assignments or pre-recorded lessons or powerpoints. Also, I am asking that you log into Zoom or kids with phones can get the app because this is a video calling app where teachers can set up a time for students to log in and watch the lesson (especially useful for math and high school science). I have asked teachers to think outside the box... so do not be surprised when you see some real-life skills being implemented and grading. Don't worry about technology though... it's not all going to be digital... there will be some book work too, but we are balancing it all. The work your students had these past couple of weeks will be extended until April 13th. Teachers will have their new assignments ready to go for the week of the 13th.

There will be a very important day of each week where I will need your help. Mondays will be the pickup/drop off day each week where you... or your child driver... will need to drop off work and pick up any new work each week. It will be like you are dropping off your students. We will be there from 7:00 am- 5:30 pm with tables set up in the office by grade, so you drop off whatever work is due and pick up whatever is there. Please abide by this... we are doing our best to not have a lot of contact.

Teachers will have all grades in by Friday of each week. They will be available for you to contact via email or messenger or text... same as the regular school year. Office hours will be limited so please do not call the school expecting an immediate response.

Tuition will still be collected for April and May. Mrs. Vicky will be in the office each Monday so on April 13th you may all pay tuition for April (no late charges of course). Also, the re-enrollment fee is still \$75.00 for the rest of this year! You can always call her at school on Mondays and pay with a card over the phone.
