Choices

This option is offered since the state allows parents to have the choice whether to send their child(ren) back to school or keep them home. **Due to the independent nature of home learning, families interested in maintaining their status remotely must be a good candidate for this model.** Candidacy is shown by a history of academic excellence, strong executive functioning skills, and parent agreement to monitor and facilitate learning. Families may also indicate a health or medical reason for their decision to remain in a remote capacity.

On-Campus Learning

- Limited visitors
- Temp. checks daily--parent must wait and take child home if temp. is 100.4 or higher

- Tuition is the same as what is stated in the handbook.

Home Learning

- Work packets
- Reliable internet
- Pick up/drop off times
- No on-campus activities
- Teacher videos of lessons
- Parent facilitator and monitoring of work
- Recordings/streaming of ceremonies, chapel, etc...
- No participation in athletics
- Students not eligible for certain honors--highest class GPA, Valedictorian, etc...
- Tuition is the same as what is stated in the handbook.

As a parent of a student(s) at CCCA for the 2020-2021 school year, please indicate whether you would like to choose on-campus learning or home learning. If you choose home learning, we will have a meeting to discuss home learning in its entirety. Please understand that certain restrictions on students who participate in home learning is not meant as a punishment; it is a fair and equitable way to treat the reliability and validity of learning for all students.

Parents that choose to have their student(s) return to campus in August, will be subject to daily temperature checks, which means that families must understand there will be a longer wait time in the morning dropping off your children and must plan accordingly. If there is a temperature of 100.4 or higher, the student would need to leave immediately and will be given a packet of clear instructions that must be followed upon returning.

In the case that there is someone with a positive test, then that student cannot return for 10 days and must have a negative test clearance to return. Other students might be subject to quarantine as well.

With the help from our staff and wonderful volunteers, we will put extra cleaning and sanitizing in place for ALL areas in the school, we will be limiting visitors on campus, and limiting our group gatherings. In the event of another mandated school closure, we have a plan in place for that as well.
