FAQ

- 1. Will temperatures be taken every day? Yes... we will check temperatures each morning and parents will need to wait until their child's temperature is taken before they can leave campus.
- 2. What is the liability waiver that will need to be signed? The waiver states that although CCCA will do its absolute best to protect against COVID 19, there is still a risk of exposure, so if that happens, the school cannot be held liable.
- 3. If cases continue to rise, will masks be mandatory or any other measures take place, besides a possible school closure? *Absolutely! Precautionary measures can always change based on the nature of this virus.*
- 4. What is the plan for PE/Chapel/lunch for limiting capacity? We have already scheduled 1 class per PE. We have 4 different lunch times now, so that will help with spreading students out and the same with chapel. Limited classes at one time.
- 5. In the event of a positive case in a student/faculty member, what is the plan? Would the whole class be subject to quarantine or have to get tested? We have specific instructions in place where others who are exposed will need to be quarantined and if symptoms arise, then tested.
- 6. Normally the school has the 24-hour rule to follow if a child is sick, is that still the case or will there be different guidelines for the virus? Much different guidelines. If a child has a fever of 100.4 or higher, they will need to come back with a doctor clearance. Some parents are not happy with this, but this is the only way to ensure that children are checked out extensively.
- 7. If parents choose home learning, will they be doing the exact same thing as kids who will be on campus? It can never be the exact the same thing because the hands-on projects, technology usage, etc... is hard to replicate at home but the syllabus will be the same. It will be more difficult for students to get in contact with their teachers during the day, as they will be teaching on-campus all day long.

- 8. If parents choose one plan and for whatever reason is not happy, can they switch to the other or is it a definite choice all year? One change will be allowed unless there is a medical reason. We cannot have students going from home to school back to home and back to school. We have to keep some consistency in their learning.
- *9.* **If parents choose home learning, can my child still participate in sports?** *No, they cannot. Students must be on-campus to participate in sports. Students will not be allowed to switch from school to home and back to school just in time for a sports season.*
