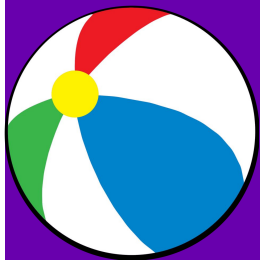
I'm practical – that's what I am!

And I'm not ashamed to tell my reason!



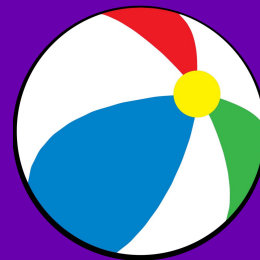

It Starts with Obedience

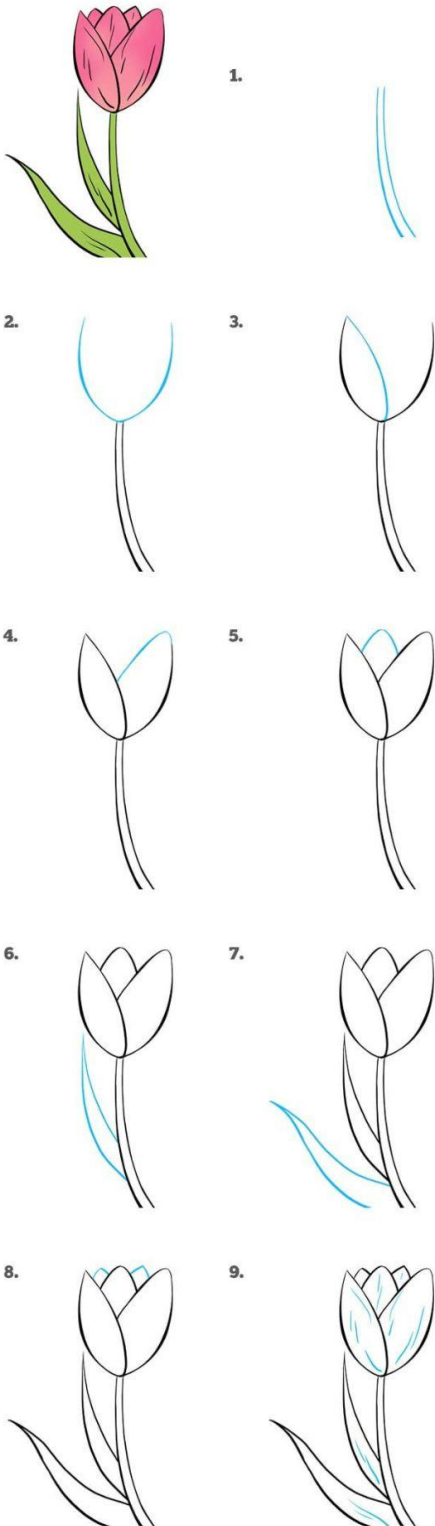
Honoring is respecting them and their opinions. It is treating them with dignity around others.
