It took several months we had to get passports, plane tickets, and worst of all 3 shots. All the time I prayed that God would use me. Once we were in Peru, we worked on several projects. On one occasion we made a trip to the market place where we were going to pass out Bible tracts. Not only did the people take one tract, they wanted one for their friends. After they were all passed out, I began to look around. I saw several people sitting and reading the tracts. This experience changed my life, as a result my passion for missions has increased, and God showed me that what I do for Him will make a difference.
