Meet Our Co-Workers, the Cochrells

Buenos días! We are Aaron & Stephenie Cochrell, church planting missionaries in the city of Cusco, Peru. I, Aaron, was saved at age 5 when I spoke to my Mom after church one Sunday night and came to understand what heaven and hell were and what God expected of me to be in heaven one day. Stephenie was saved at age 4 at home with her Mom after talking about what Christ did for her in dying on the cross. From a young age we both enjoyed being involved in different ministries with kids and serving where we could. After High School, Stephenie spent 7 months in Brazil where she lived and helped a missionary couple. I spent 11 months in Peru to learn Spanish and experience missions first hand during my junior in college. God used this time for each of us in our respective countries to open up our eyes to the work of missions and how God could use us. We met at Piedmont Baptist College in North Carolina in 2006 and were married in 2008. Since that time, we have had 3 kids. Joel is 5, Liz is 3, and Levi is 16 months old. We arrived in Peru in August of 2010 and spent a year in language school and then a little over 2 years helping a church plant find a pastor and mature so they could continue on their own. We just arrived back in Peru in March of this year and are getting started with a new church plant. God has provided a church planting team and a target location for us to begin meeting people and establishing relationships. Our goal is to raise up a strong church that can be an example and pattern for subsequent church plants. Nothing is impossible with God and we are confident in the work He does in and through us!!

Please pray for the Cochrells, for the wisdom needed as they plant a church and reach others for the Lord. An interesting note is that we meet the Cochrells when we all attended the Baptist Mid Missions Candidate Seminar in Cleveland, OH 2009. Who ever thought we would be ministering together, God did! We appreciate them very much.
