Then we are so **thankful** for your prayers on behalf of my wife's family in the home-going to glory of her brother, Pastor José Costa, after many years of shepherding the Calvary Baptist Church. The family has experienced God's comfort and grace in an amazing way.

Please continue to pray for our daughters as they study (Stacy here and Keila in the States), and for our family as we plan a trip to the States next summer to enroll Stacy in college. Pray that God would give her wisdom in her choice of a good Bible college and her desire to pursue a music ministry degree.

Pray also as I get my annual check-up exams this month. It has been four years since I had cancer surgery, and we are praying for another year clear!
